The February meeting of the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Commission has been cancelled. Due to the light February agenda, all scheduled business will be presented at the next meeting of the TWRC (March 19-20) at the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency Region II headquarters in Nashville.

The TWRC committee meetings will start at 1 p.m. on March 19. The full commission meeting will begin at 9 a.m. on March 20.

The TWRC serves as the governing body of the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency (TWRA). The public and media are invited to attend the TWRC meetings.

## **TWRA TO AUCTION CONTRABAND FIREARMS IN HARDEMAN COUNTY**

In accordance with Tennessee State Law, the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency (TWRA) will offer for sale at public auction firearms which have been declared contraband by the Hardeman County General Sessions Court. These firearms were confiscated from persons convicted of violating Tennessee's Wildlife Laws.

The sale will be held on Saturday March 8, 2008, at 10:00 am. CST at the Hardeman County Courthouse located in Bolivar, TN. Firearms for sale to the highest bidder on this date are:

- .270 caliber Winchester rifle.
- .25-06 caliber Remington Model 700 rifle with Redfield 3x9 scope.

Sale of these firearms is open to persons 18 years of age or older and legally capable of possessing a firearm under state and federal laws. Payment terms for this sale are cash, certified check or money order.

### **SPRING QUOTA TURKEY HUNTS DEADLINE IS FEBRUARY 13**

Hunters have until midnight February 13, to apply for the 2008 spring quota turkey hunts, reminds the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency (TWRA). A list of available spring turkey quota hunts is available at license agents and online at [www.tnwildlife.org](http://www.tnwildlife.org).

**Remember, there will be no mail-in quota hunt applications; you must apply online or at a license agent.**

Hunters may walk in to any license agent (including TWRA Regional Offices) and apply. You will need your TWRA ID number and required fees, if any. Annual Sportsman and Lifetime Sportsman license holders and seniors with a type 167 permit are not required to pay a permit fee.

Using the 2008 Spring Turkey Quota Hunt instruction sheet, select the hunt choices for the areas you wish to apply. After applying, the license agent will give the applicant a receipt listing name, address, hunt choices and fees. Be sure to verify all information (including address) on application receipt to ensure you will receive quota hunt information after the drawing.

Hunters with Internet access may go to [www.tnwildlife.org](http://www.tnwildlife.org) and apply for a spring quota turkey hunt. Click on On-Line Licenses. Once you have accessed the Internet site, follow the on-screen directions. Annual Sportsman and Lifetime Sportsman license holders and seniors with the type 167 permit are exempt from the internet fees.
