4-Mile "Old Peckerwood Landing" Ecological Nature Trail:

Birdsong Resort, Marina and Campground, Camden Kentucky Lake, Tennessee, offers new for 2005 a two-mile nature trail that winds along the cool, shady, lazy creek sides in the Tennessee National Wildlife Refuge (TNWR). Enjoy the natural abundance of wildlife in its natural habitat, observe the biological communities along this relaxing journey through wetlands, marshland, corn and soybean crop fields planted for waterfowl and deer feeding. Densely-wooded trek through the TNWR, then take an additional 2-mile journey along a quaint, winding country road leading to the breathtaking view at Peckerwood Landing overlooking the scenic Tennessee River.
